UNDERSTANDING THE FUNDAMENTALS

Kelly Wade Fry has been striving to focus on the big picture in her business and allow her team members to grow as leaders. Learning to delegate confidently can be difficult, so for help, she turned to a Vistage peer advisory group facilitated by Chair John Vegas.

WORKING ON THE BUSINESS
